None of the Shareholders was required under the Listing Rules to abstain from voting on the Proposed Resolutions at the 2019 AGM. None of the Shareholders has stated in the Company’s circular dated 29 July 2019 (the “**Circular**”) his/her/its intention to vote against or to abstain from voting on any of the Proposed Resolutions at the 2019 AGM.

Boardroom Share Registrars (HK) Limited, the Hong Kong branch share registrar of the Company, was appointed and acted as the scrutineer for the vote-taking at the 2019 AGM.
