On 2 April 2020 (after trading hours of the Stock Exchange), the Company entered into the Placing Agreement with the Placing Agent pursuant to which the Placing Agent has conditionally agreed, as the placing agent of the Company, to procure on a best effort basis to not less than six (6) Placees, who and whose ultimate beneficial owners (if any) shall be Independent Third Parties, to subscribe for up to 480,000,000 Placing Shares at the Placing Price of HK\$0.0233 per Placing Share. The Placing Shares will be allotted and issued pursuant to the General Mandate.

Assuming there will be no change in the issued share capital of the Company between the date of this announcement and the Completion, the maximum number of 480,000,000 Placing Shares under the Placing represents 20% of the existing issued share capital of the Company as at the date of this announcement and approximately 16.67% of the issued share capital of the Company as enlarged by the allotment and issue of all the Placing Shares.

The Placing Price of HK\$0.0233 per Placing Share represents (i) a discount of approximately 19.66% to the closing price of HK\$0.029 per Share as quoted on the Stock Exchange on the date of the Placing Agreement; and (ii) a discount of approximately 11.74% to the average closing price of HK\$0.0264 per Share as quoted on the Stock Exchange for the last five consecutive trading days immediately preceding the date of the Placing Agreement.

Assuming that all the Placing Shares are fully placed, the gross proceeds from the Placing will be approximately HK\$11.2 million and the net proceeds (after deduction of placing fees and other expenses of the Placing) from the Placing will be approximately HK\$10.8 million, representing a net placing price of approximately HK\$0.0225 per Placing Share. The Directors intend to use the net proceeds for the general working capital of the Group.

To the best knowledge, information and belief of the Directors, having made all reasonable enquiries, the Placing Agent and its ultimate beneficial owner(s) are Independent Third Parties.

The Placing Agent will charge the Company a placing fee of 3% of the aggregate Placing Price of the Placing Shares placed by the Placing Agent. The placing fee payable to the Placing Agent under the Placing Agreement was negotiated on arm's length basis between the Company and the Placing Agent and determined with reference to, amongst other things, the prevailing market commission rate for similar transactions, the size of the Placing and the price performance of the Shares.

The Directors consider that the terms of the Placing Agreement, including the placing fee, are fair and reasonable based on the current market conditions and the Placing is in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

Placees

The Placing Shares are to be placed on a best effort basis to not less than six (6) Places, who and whose ultimate beneficial owners (if any) shall be Independent Third Parties. Upon Completion, it is expected that none of the Places will become a substantial shareholder of the Company.

Number of Placing Shares

Assuming there will be no change in the issued share capital of the Company between the date of this announcement and the Completion, the maximum number of 480,000,000 Placing Shares under the Placing represents 20% of the existing issued share capital of the Company as at the date of this announcement and approximately 16.67% of the issued share capital of the Company as enlarged by the allotment and issue of all the Placing Shares.

The aggregate nominal value of the maximum of 480,000,000 Placing Shares under the Placing will be HK\$4,800,000.

Placing Price

The Placing Price of HK\$0.0233 per Placing Share represents (i) a discount of approximately 19.66% to the closing price of HK\$0.029 per Share as quoted on the Stock Exchange on the date of the Placing Agreement; and (ii) a discount of approximately 11.74% to the average closing price of HK\$0.0264 per Share as quoted on the Stock Exchange for the last five consecutive trading days immediately preceding the date of the Placing Agreement.

The Placing Price was determined and negotiated on an arm's length basis between the Company and the Placing Agent with reference to the prevailing market price of the Shares and the recent trading performance of the Shares. The Directors consider that the Placing Price is fair and reasonable based on the current market conditions and in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

Ranking of Placing Shares

The Placing Shares will rank, upon issue, pari passu in all respects with the Shares in issue on the date of allotment and issue of the Placing Shares.

Condition of the Placing

Completion of the Placing is conditional upon the Listing Committee of the Stock Exchange having granted approval for the listing of, and permission to deal in, the Placing Shares.

If the above condition is not fulfilled by 15 April 2020 (or such other date as may be agreed in writing between the Company and the Placing Agent), all rights, obligations and liabilities of the Company and the Placing Agent under the Placing Agreement shall cease and terminate and neither of the parties shall have any claim against the other in respect of the Placing, save for any antecedent breach under the Placing Agreement prior to such termination.

Completion

Completion of the Placing will take place on the third Business Day after the fulfillment of the condition as set out above or such other date agreed by the Company and the Placing Agent.

Application for listing of the Placing Shares

Application will be made by the Company to the Stock Exchange for the listing of, and permission to deal in, the Placing Shares.

General Mandate to issue the Placing Shares

The Placing Shares will be allotted and issued under the General Mandate granted to the Directors at the annual general meeting of the Company held on 21 November 2019, subject to the limit up to 480,000,000 Shares (representing 20% of the aggregate number of issued Shares on that date). As at the date of this announcement, the Company has not utilised the General Mandate and the maximum number of 480,000,000 Placing Shares under the Placing represents the entire General Mandate.

The allotment and issue of the Placing Shares is not subject to Shareholders' approval.

Termination of the Placing Agreement

Pursuant to the Placing Agreement, the Placing Agent is entitled to terminate the arrangements set out in the Placing Agreement by notice in writing prior to 10:00 a.m. on the Completion Date (or such other date as may be agreed between the Parties), if in its reasonable opinion, the success of the Placing would be materially and adversely affected by any of the following force majeure events:

- (a) the introduction of any new laws or regulations or any changes in existing laws or regulations (or the judicial interpretation thereof) or other occurrence of any natures whatsoever which may, in the reasonable opinion of the Placing Agent, materially and adversely affect the business or the financial or trading position or prospects of the Group as a whole;
- (b) the occurrence of any local, national or international event or change (whether or not forming part of a series of events or changes occurring or continuing before and/or after the date of the Placing Agreement) of a political, military, financial, economic, currency (including a change in the system under which the value of the Hong Kong currency is linked to the currency of the United States of America) or other nature (whether or not sui generis with any of the foregoing), or in the nature of any local, national, international outbreak or escalation of hostilities or armed conflict, or affecting local securities market or the occurrence of any combination of circumstances which may, in the reasonable opinion of the Placing Agent, materially and adversely affect the business or the financial or trading position or prospects of the Group as a whole or adversely prejudices the success of the Placing (such success being the placing of the Placing Shares to potential investor(s)) or otherwise makes it inexpedient or inadvisable for the Company or the Placing Agent to proceed with the Placing; or
- (c) any change in market conditions or combination of circumstances in Hong Kong (including without limitation suspension or material restriction or trading in securities) occurs which affect the success of the Placing (such success being the placing of the Placing Shares to potential investor(s)) or otherwise in the reasonable opinion of the Placing Agent makes it inexpedient or inadvisable or inappropriate for the Company or the Placing Agent to proceed with the Placing.

Upon giving notice pursuant to the paragraph above, all obligations of the Company and the Placing Agent under the Placing Agreement shall cease and determine and no party shall have any claim against any other party of the Placing Agreement in respect of any matter arising out of or in connection with the Placing Agreement, save for any antecedent breach and any rights or obligations which may have accrued under the Placing Agreement prior to such termination.

REASONS FOR THE PLACING AND THE USE OF PROCEEDS

The Company is an investment holding company and the Group is principally engaged in the trading of millwork, furniture and facade fabrication and provision of interior design, project consultancy, maintenance and interior solutions services.

Assuming that all the Placing Shares are fully placed, the gross proceeds from the Placing will be approximately HK\$11.2 million and the net proceeds (after deduction of placing fees and other expenses of the Placing) from the Placing will be approximately HK\$10.8 million, representing a net placing price of approximately HK\$0.0225 per Placing Share. The Directors intend to use the net proceeds for the general working capital of the Group.

The Directors are of the view that the Placing will strengthen the Group's financial position, widen the Company's shareholder base and is in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

The Company had not conducted any equity fund raising activities in the past twelve months immediately preceding the date of this announcement.
