Completion and return of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the AGM or any adjournment thereof should you so wish.

In view of the ongoing novel coronavirus outbreak, the Company will take certain precautionary measures at the venue of the AGM to ensure the safety of attendees, including (but not limited to) requiring all attendees to have body temperature check and wear face masks. #### INTRODUCTION

At the forthcoming AGM, resolutions will be proposed to seek the Shareholders' approval for, among other things, (i) the granting of the General Mandate and the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors; and (ii) the re-election of retiring Directors.

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information relating to the resolutions to be proposed at the AGM for the granting of the General Mandate (including the extended General Mandate) and the Repurchase Mandate and the re-election of retiring Directors, and the notice of the AGM.

### GENERAL MANDATE AND REPURCHASE MANDATE

At the AGM, the Directors propose to seek the approval of the Shareholders to grant to the Directors the General Mandate (including the extended General Mandate) and the Repurchase Mandate.

#### General Mandate

At the AGM, an ordinary resolution will be proposed such that the Directors be given an unconditional general mandate (i.e. the General Mandate) to allot, issue and deal with unissued Shares or underlying shares of the Company (other than by way of rights or pursuant to a share option scheme for employees of the Company or Directors and/or any of its subsidiaries or pursuant to any scrip dividend scheme or similar arrangements providing for the allotment and issue of Shares in lieu of whole or part of the dividend on Shares in accordance with the Bye-laws) or make or grant offers, agreements, options and warrants which might require the exercise of such power, of up to 20% of the number of issued Shares as at the date of passing of the relevant resolution.

In addition, a separate ordinary resolution will further be proposed for extending the General Mandate authorising the Directors to allot, issue and deal with Shares to the extent of the Shares repurchased pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate. Details on the Repurchase Mandate are further elaborated below.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the Company had an aggregate of 10,971,634,030 Shares in issue. Subject to the passing of the resolutions for the approval of the General Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased between the Latest Practicable Date and the date of the AGM, the Company would be allowed under the General Mandate to allot, issue and deal with a maximum of 2,194,326,806 Shares.

Any issue of new Shares in the Company is subject to approval from the Stock Exchange for the listing of and permission to deal in such new Shares.

#### Repurchase Mandate

At the AGM, an ordinary resolution will also be proposed such that the Directors be given an unconditional general mandate to repurchase Shares (i.e. the Repurchase Mandate) on the Stock Exchange of an aggregate amount of up to 10% of the number of issued Shares as at the date of passing of the relevant resolution.

Subject to the passing of the resolution for the approval of the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased between the Latest Practicable Date and the date of the AGM, the Company would be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 1,097,163,403 Shares.

The General Mandate (including the extended General Mandate) and the Repurchase Mandate, if approved, shall continue to be in force during the period from the date of passing of the resolutions for the approval of the General Mandate (including the extended General Mandate) and the Repurchase Mandate up to (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company; (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Bye-laws, the Companies Act or any applicable laws of Bermuda to be held; or (iii) the revocation or variation of the General Mandate (including the extended General Mandate) or the Repurchase Mandate (as the case may be) by ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in general meeting, whichever occurs first.

An explanatory statement in connection with the Repurchase Mandate is set out in Appendix I to this circular. The explanatory statement contains all the requisite information required under the Listing Rules to be given to the Shareholders to enable them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the resolution approving the Repurchase Mandate.

### RE-ELECTION OF RETIRING DIRECTORS

According to Bye-laws 88(1) and 88(2), at each annual general meeting, one-third of the Directors for the time being, or, if their number is not a multiple of three, then the number nearest to, but not less than one-third, shall retire from office by rotation, provided that every Director shall be subject to retirement by rotation at least once every three years. A retiring Director shall be eligible for re-election.

Mr. Ding Xiaobin, Ms. Li Jie and Mr. Zhang Jing shall retire from office by rotation at the AGM, and being eligible, each of them will offer himself/herself for re-election as non-executive/independent non-executive Director (as the case may be).

At the AGM, ordinary resolutions will be proposed to re-elect each of Mr. Ding Xiaobin, Ms. Li Jie and Mr. Zhang Jing as non-executive/independent non-executive Director (as the case may be).

The appointments of retiring Directors had been reviewed and assessed by the nomination committee of the Company (the “**Nomination Committee**”), the Board is of the view that Mr. Ding Xiaobin, Ms. Li Jie and Mr. Zhang Jing are able to continue fulfilling their duties as required and Mr. Zhang Jing meets the independence guidelines set out in Rule 3.13 of the Listing Rules.

### **Nomination process for the independent non-executive Director subject to re-election at the AGM**

The Nomination Committee is also of the view that Mr. Zhang Jing would bring to the Board his own perspective, skills and experience, as further described in his biography in Appendix II to this circular. Based on the board diversity policy adopted by the Company, the Nomination Committee considers that Mr. Zhang Jing can contribute to the diversity of the Board. In particular, the Nomination Committee has considered his extensive experience in corporate management. Based on the annual independence confirmation of Mr. Zhang Jing, the Nomination Committee is of the opinion that he continues to fulfil the independence requirement under Rule 3.13 of the Listing Rules.

Therefore, the Board, with the recommendation of the Nomination Committee, has nominated Mr. Zhang Jing for re-election as independent non-executive Director at the AGM.

Details of the retiring Directors who are proposed to be re-elected at the AGM are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

Pursuant to Rule 13.39(4) of the Listing Rules, any vote of Shareholders at a general meeting must be taken by poll except where the chairman, in good faith, decides to allow a resolution which relates purely to a procedural or administrative matter to be voted on by a show of hands. Accordingly, all the resolutions proposed at the AGM will be taken by way of poll.

After the conclusion of the AGM, the poll vote results will be published on the website of the Stock Exchange at <http://www.hkexnews.hk> and the website of the Company at <http://www.irasia.com/listco/hk/cfii>.

To the best of the Directors' knowledge, information and belief, having made all reasonable enquiries, no Shareholder is required to abstain from voting on any resolution to be proposed at the AGM.

### RESPONSIBILITY STATEMENT

This circular, for which the Directors collectively and individually accept full responsibility, includes particulars given in compliance with the Listing Rules for the purpose of giving information with regard to the Company. The Directors, having made all reasonable enquiries, confirm that to the best of their knowledge and belief the information contained in this circular is accurate and complete in all material respects and not misleading or deceptive, and there are no other matters the omission of which would make any statement herein or this circular misleading.

### RECOMMENDATION

The Directors consider the proposed grant of the General Mandate (including the extended General Mandate) and the Repurchase Mandate and the proposed re-election of retiring Directors are in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole. Accordingly, the Directors recommend the Shareholders to vote in favour of the relevant resolutions to be proposed at the AGM.

*This Appendix serves as an explanatory statement, as required by the Listing Rules, to provide requisite information to you for your consideration of the Repurchase Mandate.*

## **1. REPURCHASE OF SECURITIES FROM CONNECTED PARTIES**

The Listing Rules prohibit the Company from knowingly purchasing its securities on the Stock Exchange from a “core connected person”, that is, a director, chief executive or substantial shareholder of the Company or any of its subsidiaries or their respective close associates and a core connected person is prohibited from knowingly selling to the Company his/her/its securities of the Company.

No core connected person of the Company has notified the Company that he/she/it has a present intention to sell any Shares to the Company nor has any such core connected person undertaken not to sell any of the Shares held by him/her/it to the Company in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is passed.

## **2. SHARE CAPITAL**

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the Company had an aggregate of 10,971,634,030 issued Shares.

Subject to the passing of the proposed resolution for the approval of the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased by the Company prior to the AGM date, the Company will be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 1,097,163,403 Shares, representing 10% of the number of issued Shares as at the date of passing of the relevant resolution.

## **3. REASONS FOR THE REPURCHASE MANDATE**

The Directors believe that approving the Repurchase Mandate is in the best interests of the Company and its Shareholders as a whole. An exercise of the Repurchase Mandate may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net assets per Share and/or earnings per Share and will only be made when the Directors believe that a repurchase will benefit the Company and its Shareholders as a whole.

## **4. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES**

Repurchases would be funded entirely from the Company’s available cash flow or working capital facilities which will be funds legally available under Bermuda laws and the memorandum of association of the Company and the Bye-laws for such purpose.

An exercise of the Repurchase Mandate in full may have a material adverse impact on the working capital and gearing position of the Company compared with those as at 30 June 2020, being the date of its latest published audited consolidated accounts. The Directors do not, however, intend to make any repurchase in circumstances that would have a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company.

## 6. DISCLOSURE OF INTERESTS AND MINIMUM PUBLIC HOLDING

None of the Directors or, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, their close associates, have any present intention to sell to the Company or its subsidiaries any of the Shares in the Company if the Repurchase Mandate is approved at the AGM.

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will exercise the powers of the Company to make repurchases pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the Listing Rules and applicable laws of Bermuda.

If a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases on the Company exercising its powers to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code. As a result, a Shareholder or group of Shareholders acting in concert could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory general offer in accordance with Rules 26 and 32 of the Takeovers Code.

On the basis of the current shareholdings of the above Shareholders, an exercise of the Repurchase Mandate in full will not result in any of them becoming obliged to make a mandatory offer under Rules 26 or 32 of the Takeovers Code.

At as the Latest Practicable Date, the Directors had no intention to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent that will result in a requirement of the above Shareholders, or any other persons to make a general offer under the Takeovers Code or the number of Shares in the hands of the public falling below the prescribed minimum percentage of 25%.

The Directors are not aware of any consequences which could arise under the Takeovers Code as a consequence of any repurchases pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate in full.

## 7. SHARES REPURCHASE MADE BY THE COMPANY

The Company had not purchased any of its Shares (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise) during the previous six months immediately prior to the Latest Practicable Date.

*Details of the Directors who will retire from office at the AGM and being eligible, will offer themselves for re-election at the AGM, are set out below:*

**(1) MR. DING XIAOBIN (“MR. DING”)**

Mr. Ding, aged 51, graduated with a master of business administration degree from Huazhong University of Science and Technology, and has been honored the academic title of economist. He has worked for different business enterprises in various fields, including banking, futures, clothes, import & export and investments. Currently as the managing director of Guangdong Poly Investment Holdings Limited, he acts as the investment consultant for projects in relation to clothes sales, harbour operation, agricultural, chemical synthesis and so on, with close cooperative relationship with the commercial banks, insurance corporation and fund corporation. Mr. Ding has rich experience in management, merger and acquisition, restructuring. He joined the Group on 8 December 2003.

Mr. Ding has entered into a letter of appointment with the Company for a term of two years commencing from 20 March 2020. He is subject to retirement by rotation and/or re-election at general meetings in accordance with the Bye-laws. He is entitled to a fixed annual emolument of HK\$60,000, which is determined by the Board with reference to his duties and responsibilities within the Company and the prevailing market conditions and he may entitle to discretionary bonus depending on the performance of the Group. Save as disclosed herein, Mr. Ding is not entitled to any other benefits.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Ding had not held any other directorship in public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas in the last three years. Mr. Ding does not have any relationship with any directors, senior management or substantial or controlling Shareholders of the Company nor held any position with the Group.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, save for being the beneficial owner of 1,300,000 Shares, Mr. Ding did not, and was not deemed to, have any interests or short positions in the shares, underlying shares or debentures of the Company and its associated corporations within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO.

**(2) MS. LI JIE (“MS. LI”)**

Ms. Li, aged 62, is an accountant as accredited by Bank of Communications. Ms. Li served as Executive Director of the China Everbright Bank Company Limited (Stock code: 06818) from September 2016 to August 2018, Member of CPC Committee of China Everbright Bank from January 2003 to August 2018, Executive Vice President of China Everbright Bank from August 2003 to August 2018. She also concurrently serves as Director of China UnionPay Co., Ltd., Director of Sun Life Everbright Life Insurance Co., Ltd. and Director of Everbright Jin’ou Asset Management Limited. She joined China Everbright Bank in 2001 and successively served as the General Manager of the Finance and Accounting Department, and the Planning and Finance Department of the Bank. She was Deputy Chief of the Planning Division, Chief of the Finance and Accounting Division and Deputy General Manager of Jinan Branch, and Deputy General Manager and General Manager of Zhuhai Branch of Bank of Communication. She is a graduate of the Open University of China of Finance. She joined the Group on 8 January 2019.

Ms. Li has entered into a letter of appointment with the Company for a term of two years commencing from 8 January 2019. She is subject to retirement by rotation and/or re-election at general meetings in accordance with the Bye-laws. She is entitled to a fixed annual emolument of HK\$120,000, which is determined by the Board with reference to her duties and responsibilities within the Company and the prevailing market conditions and she may entitle to discretionary bonus depending on the performance of the Group. Save as disclosed herein, Ms. Li is not entitled to any other benefits.

Save as disclosed above, Ms. Li had not held any other directorship in public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas in the last three years. Ms. Li does not have any relationship with any directors, senior management or substantial or controlling Shareholders of the Company nor held any position with the Group.
