PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES FOR THE AGM

The health of the Shareholders, staff and stakeholders is of paramount importance to the Company. In view of the ongoing Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, the Company will implement the following precautionary measures at the AGM to protect attending shareholders, staff and stakeholders from the risk of infection:

- (i) Compulsory body temperature checks will be conducted for every Shareholder, proxy or other attendee at each entrance of the meeting venue. Any person with a body temperature of over 37.4 degrees Celsius may be denied entry into the meeting venue or be required to leave the meeting venue.
- (ii) Each attendee must wear a surgical face mask throughout the meeting and inside the meeting venue, and to maintain a safe distance between seats.

1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide the Shareholders with information in respect of certain resolutions to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to be held on 30 July 2021.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

2. PROPOSED RE-ELECTION OF RETIRING DIRECTORS

In accordance with Article 108 of the Articles of Association, Mr. HA Chak Hung and Mr. IP Chu Shing shall retire from office at the Annual General Meeting, and being eligible, will offer themselves for re-election at the Annual General Meeting.

The Nomination Committee has held a meeting on 30 June 2021 to review the structure and composition of the Board, assess the independence of all independent non-executive Directors and consider the re-election of the retiring Directors, taking into account the qualifications, skills and experience, time commitment and contribution of the retiring Directors with reference to the nomination principles and criteria set out in the Company's Board Diversity Policy and Director Nomination Policy and the Company's corporate strategy. The Nomination Committee has recommended to the Board on re-election of all the retiring Directors.

Pursuant to Rule 17.46A of GEM Listing Rules, the biographical details of the Directors proposed for re-election at the Annual General Meeting are set out in Appendix I to this circular.

3. PROPOSED APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR

BDO Limited will retire as the independent auditors of the Company at the Annual General Meeting and, being eligible, offer themselves for re-appointment.

Upon the recommendation of the audit committee of the Company, the Board proposed that, subject to the approval of the Shareholders at the AGM, BDO Limited be appointed as the external auditor of the Company to hold office until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company.

4. PROPOSED GRANTING OF GENERAL MANDATE TO REPURCHASE SHARES

At the annual general meeting of the Company held on 30 July 2020, a general mandate was granted to the Directors to repurchase Shares. Such mandate will lapse at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting. In order to give the Company the flexibility to repurchase Shares if and when appropriate, an ordinary resolution will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to approve the granting of the Share Repurchase Mandate to the Directors to repurchase Shares on GEM of the Stock Exchange of not exceeding 10% of the total number of issued Shares of the Company as at the date of passing of the proposed ordinary resolution contained in item 5 of the notice of the Annual General Meeting as set out on pages 15 to 19 of this circular (i.e. a total of 48,000,000 Shares on the basis that the issued share capital of the Company remains 480,000,000 shares from the Latest Practicable Date to the date of the Annual General Meeting).

An explanatory statement required by the GEM Listing Rules to provide the Shareholders with requisite information reasonably necessary for them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the granting of the Shares Repurchase Mandate is set out in Appendix II to this circular.

5. PROPOSED GRANTING OF GENERAL MANDATE TO ISSUE SHARES

At the annual general meeting of the Company held on 30 July 2020, a general mandate was granted to the Directors to issue Shares. Such mandate will lapse at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting. In order to give the Company the flexibility to issue Shares if and when appropriate, an ordinary resolution will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to approve the granting of the Issuance Mandate to the Directors to allot, issue or deal with additional Shares of not exceeding 20% of the total number of issued Shares of the Company as at the date of passing of the proposed ordinary resolution contained in item 6 of the notice of the Annual General Meeting as set out on pages 15 to 19 of this circular (i.e. a total of 96,000,000 Shares on the basis that the issued share capital of the Company remains 480,000,000 shares from the Latest Practicable Date to the date of the Annual General Meeting). An ordinary resolution to extend the Issuance Mandate by adding the number of Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to the Share Repurchase Mandate will also be proposed at the Annual General Meeting.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the Company has an aggregate of 480,000,000 Shares in issue. Subject to the passing of the resolutions for the approval of the Issue Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased between the Latest Practicable Date and the date of the AGM, the Company would be allowed under the Issue Mandate to allot, issue and deal with a maximum of 96,000,000 Shares.

The Directors wish to state they have no present intention to repurchase any Shares pursuant to the Shares Repurchase Mandate or issue Shares pursuant to the Issuance Mandate (if granted to the Directors of the AGM).

6. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING, PROXY AND CORPORATE REPRESENTATIVE ARRANGEMENT AND CLOSURE OF REGISTER OF MEMBERS

The notice of the Annual General Meeting is set out on pages 15 to 19 of this circular.

Pursuant to the GEM Listing Rules and the Articles of Association, any vote of Shareholders at a general meeting must be taken by poll except where the chairman decides to allow a resolution relating to a procedural or administrative matter to be voted on by a show of hands. An announcement on the poll results will be published by the Company after the Annual General Meeting in the manner prescribed under the GEM Listing Rules.

A form of proxy for use at the Annual General Meeting is enclosed with this circular and such form of proxy is also published on the websites of GEM (<http://www.hkgem.com>) and the Company (www.grandtalentsgroup.com.hk). To be valid, the form of proxy must be completed and signed in accordance with the instructions printed thereon and deposited, together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of that power of attorney or authority at the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at Level 54, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Hong Kong as soon as possible but in any event not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for the Annual General Meeting or the adjourned meeting (as the case may be). Completion and delivery of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting at the Annual General Meeting if you so wish, and in such case, the form of proxy previously submitted shall be deemed to be revoked.

The following are details of the Directors who will retire and being eligible, offer themselves for re-election at the Annual General Meeting.

(1) Mr. Ha Chak Hung (夏澤虹)

Mr. Ha Chak Hung, aged 46, is the Chairman and executive Director of the Group. Mr. Ha was appointed as a Director on 23 October 2017 and was redesignated as our executive Director on 21 September 2018. Mr. Ha is responsible for the overall strategic management and development of our business and operations. Mr. Ha is currently a director of Talent Mart Construction Co., Limited and Talent Mark Development Limited, indirect wholly-owned subsidiaries of the Company. He is also a member of the Remuneration Committee and Nomination Committee. Mr. Ha graduated with a Bachelor of Business Administration from Chu Hai College in January 2000. He also completed a Postgraduate Certificate in Business and Management in University of Bradford in July 2014 through distance learning.

Mr. Ha has over 18 years of experience in the roads and highways management and maintenance industry. Mr. Ha began his career as a sales executive in Wah Lam Construction Co., Limited from 1999 to 2001. He then worked as a sales manager in Hongkong United Dockyards Limited from 2001 to 2004. Later, he worked in Good Intelligent Development Engineering Limited from May 2005 to April 2010 and Mr. Ha's major roles and responsibilities included projects co-ordination, marketing and business development. Throughout the period, he acquired extensive knowledge and expertise in the roads and highway management and maintenance industry by participating in different construction projects.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Ha does not at present, nor did he in the past three years, hold any directorships in other public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas, nor does he hold other positions in the Company or members of the Group.

Mr. Ha is deemed to have an interest in the 171,669,000 ordinary shares of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO via a controlled corporation, Talent Prime Group Limited.

Mr. Ha has executed an appointment letter with the Company for a term of three years commencing from 15 October 2018 on 21 September 2018. Under the appointment letter, he is entitled to receive a director's fee of HK\$720,000 per annum. Mr. Ha is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election at least once every three years at the annual general meeting of the Company in accordance with the provisions of the articles of association.

Mr. Ha is the Brother-in-law of Ms Chung Miu Chi, accounting manager of the Company. Save as disclosed above, Mr. Ha does not have any relationship with any directors, senior management, substantial shareholders or controlling shareholders of the Company.

There is no information which is required to be disclosed pursuant to the requirements of the provisions under Rules 17.50(2)(h) to 17.50(2)(v) of the GEM Listing Rules, and there is no other matter which needs to be brought to the attention of the shareholders.

(2) Mr. Ip Chu Shing (葉柱成)

Mr. Ip Chu Shing, aged 50, is the Chief Executive Officer and executive Director of the Group. Mr. Ip was appointed as a Director on 23 October 2017 and was redesignated as an executive Director on 21 September 2018. Mr. Ip is responsible for overseeing our operations, business development, human resources, finance and administration. Mr. Ip is currently a director of Talent Mart Construction Co., Limited and Talent Mark Development Limited, indirect wholly-owned subsidiaries of the Company. Mr. Ip obtained a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering and a Master of Science in Civil Engineering from San Jose State University in December 1994 and December 1998 respectively.

Mr. Ip has over 25 years of experience in the civil engineering industry, during which he gathered extensive knowledge of the industry and established close relationships with customers, suppliers and subcontractors alike. Mr. Ip began his career as a site engineer in Kin Wing Engineering Company Limited in September 1994 with his last position held as a project engineer in 1997. He then worked as an assistant engineer in Atkins China Limited from May 1997 to August 1997. From 1997 to 1998, Mr. Ip worked as a project manager in Man Wah General Contractor Company Inc. in the United States. He also worked as a design engineer in T. Y. Lin International Consultant Limited in the United States from 1999 to 2000. From 2000 to 2001, Mr. Ip worked as a transportation engineer in California Department of Transportation in the United States. After working as a project engineer in HUD General Engineering Services Limited from 2001 to 2003, he worked as a project manager in Ki Wan Development Limited from April 2005 to December 2010.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Ip does not at present, nor did he in the past three years, hold any directorships in other public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas, nor does he hold other positions in the Company or members of the Group.

Mr. Ip is deemed to have an interest in the 171,669,000 ordinary shares of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO via a controlled corporation, Talent Prime Group Limited.

Mr. Ip has executed an appointment letter with the Company for a term of three years commencing from 15 October 2018 on 21 September 2018. Under the appointment letter, he is entitled to receive a director's fee of HK\$720,000 per annum. Mr. Ip is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election at least once every three years at an annual general meeting of the Company in accordance with the provisions of the articles of association.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Ip does not have any relationship with any directors, senior management, substantial shareholders or controlling shareholders of the Company.

The following is an explanatory statement required by the GEM Listing Rules to provide the Shareholders with requisite information reasonably necessary for them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the ordinary resolution to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting in relation to the granting of the Share Repurchase Mandate.

1. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 480,000,000 Shares.

Subject to the passing of the ordinary resolution set out in item 5 of the notice of the Annual General Meeting in respect of the granting of the Share Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that the issued share capital of the Company remains unchanged on the date of the Annual General Meeting, i.e. being 480,000,000 Shares, the Directors would be authorized under the Share Repurchase Mandate to repurchase, during the period in which the Share Repurchase Mandate remains in force, a total of 48,000,000 Shares, representing 10% of the total number of Shares in issue as at the date of the Annual General Meeting.

2. REASONS FOR SHARE REPURCHASE

The Directors believe that the granting of the Share Repurchase Mandate is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders.

Repurchase of Shares may, depending on the market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value per Share and/or earnings per Share and will only be made when the Directors believe that such a repurchase will benefit the Company and the Shareholders.

3. FUNDING OF SHARE REPURCHASE

The company may only apply funds legally available for share repurchase in accordance with its Memorandum and Articles of Association, the laws of the Cayman Islands and/or any other applicable laws, as the case may be.

4. IMPACT OF SHARE REPURCHASE

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company (as compared with the position disclosed in the audited accounts contained in the annual report of the Company for the year ended 31 March 2021 in the event that the Share Repurchase Mandate was to be carried out in full at any time during the proposed repurchase period. However, the Directors do not intend to exercise the Share Repurchase Mandate to such extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Company or the gearing levels which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

6. GENERAL

To the best of their knowledge and having made all reasonable enquiries, none of the Directors nor any of their respective close associates (as defined in the GEM Listing Rules) have any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company in the event that the granting of the Share Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

The Company has not been notified by any core connected persons (as defined in the GEM Listing Rules) of the Company that they have a present intention to sell any Shares to the Company, or that they have undertaken not to sell any Shares held by them to the Company in the event that the granting of the Share Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange to exercise the power of the Company to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Share Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the GEM Listing Rules and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

7. TAKEOVERS CODE

If as a result of a repurchase of Shares pursuant to the Share Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition of voting rights for the purposes of the Takeovers Code. Accordingly, a Shareholder or a group of Shareholders acting in concert (within the meaning under the Takeovers Code), depending on the level of increase in the Shareholder's interest, could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and thereby become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

To the best knowledge of the Company, as at the Latest Practicable Date, Talent Prime Group Limited, Mr. Ha Chak Hung, Mr. Ip Chu Shing, Ms. Chung Ching Yan and Ms. Lee Ming Ho were interested in 171,669,000 Shares representing approximately 35.76% of the total issued share capital of the Company. In the event that the Directors exercise in full to repurchase Shares under the Share Repurchase Mandate, the aggregate shareholding of Talent Prime Group Limited, Mr. Ha Chak Hung, Mr. Ip Chu Shing, Ms. Chung Ching Yan and Ms. Lee Ming Ho would be increased to approximately 39.74% of the issued share capital of the Company. The Directors consider that such increase in shareholding would give rise to an obligation to make a mandatory offer under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

The GEM Listing Rules prohibit a company from making repurchase on the Stock Exchange if the result of the repurchase would be that less than 25 per cent (or such minimum percentage as approved by Stock Exchange) of the issued Shares would be in public hands. The Directors do not propose to exercise the Share Repurchase Mandate which would result in less than prescribed minimum percentage of Shares in public hands. The Directors will use their best endeavours to ensure that the Share Repurchase Mandate will not be exercised to such extent that the aggregate number of Shares held by the public will fall below the prescribed minimum percentage as determined by the Stock Exchange.

8. SHARE REPURCHASE MADE BY THE COMPANY

During the 6 months prior to the Latest Practicable Date, the Company had not repurchased any of the Shares (whether on the GEM or otherwise).
