- 25% of all the Options granted will (1)become vested on the first anniversary of the vesting start date as specified in the Option Agreement (i.e. 30 August 2021) (the "Vesting Start Date");
- 6.25% of the Options granted will (2) become vested as at the end of each three month period after the first anniversary of the Vesting Start Date, such that all of the Options with the same Vesting Start Date shall become vested on the fourth anniversary of the Vesting Start Date;

provided that, among others, (i) the Option Grantee does not suffer a termination of eligibility status prior to each such vesting date and (ii) the additional vesting will be suspended during any period which the Option Grantee is on a leave of absence from the Group, as determined by the Board or by a committee appointed by the Board which consists of two or more members of the Board.

The Options were granted to the Option Grantees as incentives for their continuing commitment and contribution towards the sustainable growth of the Group by providing them with an opportunity for investment in the Company.
