5. Important: If you wish to vote for any resolution, please tick the appropriate box marked “For” or insert the relevant number of shares intended to be voted for the resolution. If you wish to vote against any resolution, please tick the appropriate box marked “Against” or insert the relevant number of shares intended to be voted against the resolution. If you wish to abstain from voting on any resolution, please tick the appropriate box marked “Abstain” or insert the relevant number of shares intended to be abstained from voting. Any abstaining vote or waiver to vote shall be disregarded as votes with voting rights for the purpose of calculating the results of that resolution. If no indication is given, your proxy may vote at his/her own discretion.
6. This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorized in writing or, in case the holder of shares is a legal person, must be either executed under its common seal or under the hand of its directors or attorney duly authorized.
7. In the case of joint holders of any shares, any of such persons may vote at the meeting, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such shares as if he/she were solely entitled thereto. However, if more than one of such joint holders is present at the meeting, either personally or by proxy, then only the vote of the person whose name stands first on the register of members in respect of such shares shall be accepted to the exclusion of the vote(s) of the other joint holder(s).
8. If this form of proxy is signed by another person under a power of attorney or other authorization documents given by the appointer, such power of attorney or other authorization documents shall be notarized. This form of proxy together with such certified copy of the power of attorney or other authorization documents must be lodged with the Company’s H share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen’s Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong (for shareholders of H shares of the Company) not less than 24 hours prior to the holding of the AGM.
9. The AGM is expected to take less than half a day. Shareholders who attend the AGM shall be responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses. Shareholders or their proxy(ies) shall provide their proof of identity when attending the AGM.
