### **New Arrangements on Dissemination of Corporate Communications**

#### **INTRODUCTION**

Pursuant to new Rule 2.07A<sup>1</sup> of the Rules (the “**Listing Rules**”) Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Stock Exchange**”) and the articles of association of Petro-King Oil Field Services Limited (the “**Company**”), the Company will disseminate the future corporate communications of the Company (the “**Corporate Communications**”<sup>2</sup>) to its Shareholders<sup>3</sup> electronically and only send Corporate Communications in printed form to the Shareholders upon request.

In this connection, the following arrangements will come into effect immediately.

#### **ARRANGEMENTS**

##### **1. Actionable Corporate Communications<sup>4</sup>**

The Company will send the Actionable Corporate Communications to its Shareholders individually in electronic form by email. If the Company does not possess the email address of a Shareholder or the email address provided is not functional<sup>5</sup>, the Company will send the Actionable Corporate Communications in printed form together with a request form for soliciting the Shareholder’s functional email address to facilitate electronic dissemination of Actionable Corporate Communications in the future.

## **2. Corporation Communications**

The Company will make the Corporate Communications available on its website (<http://www.petro-king.cn/>) and the Stock Exchange's website ([www.hkexnews.hk](http://www.hkexnews.hk)). The Shareholders are encouraged to proactively monitor the availability of all future Corporate Communications on the websites and access the Website Version<sup>6</sup> of Corporate Communications by themselves.

## **3. Provision of Shareholder's Email Address to the Company**

In support of electronic communication by email, the Company recommends its Shareholders to provide an email address by completing, signing and returning the Reply form, which will be dispatched to the Shareholders on 3 April 2024, to the Company's Hong Kong share registrar and Transfer Office (the "**Share Registrar**"), Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong. Shareholders may also provide the Company with their email address at any time in future by reasonable notice in writing to the Share Registrar or email to [petroking.ecom@computershare.com.hk](mailto:petroking.ecom@computershare.com.hk).

It is the responsibility of the Shareholders to provide email address that is functional. If the Company does not possess the email address of a Shareholder or the email address provided is not functional, the Company will act according to the above arrangements. The Company will be considered to have complied with the Listing Rules if it sends Actionable Corporate Communications to the email address provided by a Shareholder without receiving any "non-delivery message".

## **4. Request for Corporate Communications and Actionable Corporate Communications in printed form**

For those Shareholders who wish to receive a printed version of all future Corporate Communications and Actionable Corporate Communications or, if for any reason, have difficulty in gaining access to the Company's website, the Company will, upon receipt of request in writing by the Shareholder to the Share Registrar at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong or by email to [petroking.ecom@computershare.com.hk](mailto:petroking.ecom@computershare.com.hk), send future Corporate Communications and/or the relevant Corporate Communications (as the case may be) to such Shareholders in printed form free of charge.
