The proxy does not need to be a shareholder of the Company.

- This form of proxy must be signed by you or your agent duly authorised in writing or, in the case of a corporation, must either be executed under its seal or be signed by an officer or agent duly authorised in writing.
- In the case of joint registered holders of any shares, any one of such persons may vote at the AGM, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such shares as if he/she were solely entitled thereto but the vote of the senior holder who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the vote(s) of the other joint holders and, for this purpose, seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the Company’s register of members in respect of the relevant joint holding.
- The full text of resolutions 4, 5 and 6 are set out in the notice of the AGM.
- To be valid, the completed form of proxy must be received by the Company’s Hong Kong branch share registrar and transfer office, Boardroom Share Registrars (HK) Limited, at 2103B, 21/F, 148 Electric Road, North Point, Hong Kong at least 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the AGM or any adjourned meeting (as the case may be). If a form of proxy is signed by an attorney or other authority under which it is signed, the power of attorney or other authority under which it is signed or a certified copy of that power of attorney or authority (such certification to be made by either a notary public or a solicitor qualified to practice in Hong Kong) must be delivered to the Company’s Hong Kong branch share registrar and transfer office together with the form of proxy.
- Any alteration made to this form of proxy should be initialed by the person who signed the form.
- Completion and return of this form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the AGM or any adjourned meeting (as the case may be) if you so wish. If you attend and vote at the AGM, this form of proxy will be deemed to be revoked.
